Nominator Instructions

for Early Career Scientists Conducting Research in Areas Supported by the Division of Cancer Prevention:

Please put the name of the candidate at the top of the letter. Also, be sure to include your name and title in the letter. Letters must be on institutional letterhead and signed.

In one page or less (PDF format), describe the qualities of the candidate and their research focus in a DCP-related area. You may want to include the following in your letter.

The candidate's:

- Commitment to cancer prevention, cancer interception, and related research found on the DCP website at <u>Scientific Scope</u> and <u>Major Programs</u>; and
- Current and anticipated future research contributions to a DCP-supported area;
- Evidence of originality;
- Quality of research endeavors or publications to date, if any;
- · Any additional related comments that the nominator may wish to provide

Nominators may provide any additional, related comments that they believe will help reviewers evaluate the merit of the candidate's application.

Nominators should provide the candidate with the nomination letter so this can be submitted as one package with the other application materials.
